2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	Virtual sessions were conducted for each course to facilitate student learning and completion of syllabus. The faculty members have contributed a lot for the benefits of students by using several tools like WhatsApp groups, other social media tools and emails to ensure continuity in teaching-learning process. Adequate online lectures were conducted via Zoom platform for the completion of academic syllabus. Students were provided with study material by uploading the e-copies of books, scanned copies of notes, and power point presentations in ERP system. Tutorials and assignments were uploaded in Google Classroom as a part of summative assessment. MCQ based online internal theory examinations were carried out by uploading question papers in institutional ERP system. Practical sessions were arranged through online mode via You Tube streaming. End Semester Online Project Examinations of students were taken in the form of presentation-based assessments and viva-voce through Video Conferencing using Zoom Platform. A strong communication was made on a regular basis with the students to discuss their queries regarding the uploaded course material in the syllabus. As per the academic calendar, Class Timetable(s). Lectures are conducted through online Platform Zoom' for lecture delivery, conducting Orals, Group Discussions and Students' Presentations. Notes and updating student's as well as faculty about their attendance in online mode. Using the Campus ERP, student can check his progress of learning and evaluation.
