Thereafter the business of the meeting was taken up.

Item No. BM-35-14: To confirm the minutes of the last meeting of the Board of Management held on 18th July, 2014.

Resolution No. BM- 35-14: Resolved that the minutes of the last meeting of the Board of Management held on 18th July, 2014 be confirmed.

Item No. BM-36-14: To consider the report on the 'Actions Taken' by the Vidyapeeth office on the resolutions of the Board of Management.

Resolution No. BM- 36-14: Resolved that, the report of 'Actions Taken' on the resolutions of the last meeting, of the Board of Management was noted and approved with following modifications:

- (i) In action taken BM-34-14at the UG level Medical Faculty (iii) the word "Elective" to be deleted as the Research Methodology and Disaster management subjects are not elective, they are compulsory subjects.
- (ii) Normally a batch of 30 students of under graduate (Faculty of medicine) can be examined per day for practicals. .

Item No. BM-37-14: To inform the house about the actions taken by the Vice Chancellor, on behalf of the Board of Management, since its last meeting.

Resolution No. BM- 37-14: Resolved that, the following actions taken by the Vice Chancellor, on behalf of the Board of Management, be approved.

- (i) Revision in syllabus of 3rd and 4th Semester of MBA Programme of 2013-15 batch.
- (ii) Revision of examination reforms of B. Sc. (Nursing), P.B.B. Sc. (Nursing) and M. Sc. (Nursing) for 2014-15 batch.
- (iii) Consent given to start new PG Courses in Medical College.

Item No. BM-38-14: To inform the House about the major developments in the Vidyapeeth and its Constituent Colleges/Institutes, since its last meeting.

Resolution No. BM- 38-14: Resolved that, the major developments in the Vidyapeeth and its Constituent Colleges/Institutes, since last meeting of the Board of Management, be noted.

Item No. BM-39-14: To consider recommendations made by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 22nd December, 2014 related to Centre for Potential Excellence.

Resolution No. BM- 39-14: It was resolved that the report of committee appointed to examine Centre for Potential Excellence of various departments of the Constituent

Accordingly, it was further resolved that the following Centres / Laboratories of the

Constituent Colleges/Institutes be recognized as Centre for Potential Excellence:

- 1. Microbial Diversity Research Lab of Dr. D. Y. Patil Biotechnology & Bioinformatics Institute, Tathawade, Pune.
- 2. Department of Dermatology, Venereology and Leprosy, Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical, Hospital & Research Centre, Pimpri, Pune.
- 3. Oral Pathology & Microbiology Department of Dr. D. Y. Patil Dental College and Hospital, Pimpri, Pune.

Item No. BM-40-14: To consider recommendations made by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 22nd December, 2014 related to recommendations of Planning and Monitoring Board.

Resolution No. BM-40-14: After discussions it was resolved that the recommendations of the Planning and Monitoring Board be approved.

It was further resolved that following short-term (six months' duration) / long-term courses be started in the Constituent Colleges/Institutes of the Vidyapeeth.

(i) For Faculty of Medicine:

- a. To initiate process for starting new super-specialty programmes

 It was informed to house that the following five new super-specialty services have already been started in the Medical College & Hospital and applications have been submitted to MCI for starting the programmes.
 - 1. M. Ch. (Plastic & Reconstruction Surgery)
 - 2. M. Ch. (Paediatric Surgery)
 - 3. M. Ch. (Cardio Thoracic Surgery)
 - 4. D. M. (Neurology)
 - 5. D.M. (Cardiology)
- b. To start M. Optom. Programme in Optometry Institute.

It was resolved that the Master of Clinical Optometry (M. Optom.) Programme be started in the Optometry Institute in three specializations i.e.

(i) Cornea & Contact Lens, (ii) Low Vision and Rehabilitation and (iii) Applied Dispensing Optics with initial intake of 2 seats in each specialization with entry qualification of minimum 55% in Bachelor degree of Optometry.

(ii) For Faculty of Dentistry:

- a. To start Certificate Course in Geriatric Dentistry It was resolved that the Certificate Course in Geriatric Dentistry of 8 months duration with initial intake of 10 students be started in Dental College with entry qualification of BDS.
- b. To add Microbiology Laboratory to Dept. of Oral Pathology & Microbiology It was resolved that the proposal be reconsidered.

(iii) For Faculty of Biotechnology:

- a. To start training course on Flow Cytometry & Bioinformatics It was resolved that the training course on Flow Cytometry & Bioinformatics be started in Biotechnology Institute.
- b. To develop Animal & Green House in Biotechnology Institute
 It was resolved that the Green House be developed in Biotechnology Institute,
 however, for developing Animal House, the proposal be reconsidered.
- c. To initiate the proposals for New Department under the FOBB

It was resolved that the necessary departments be established under Faculty of Biotechnology and Bioinformatics, taking into consideration the current requirements of the society.

(iv) For Faculty of Management:

- a. To start Executive MBA program
 It was resolved that the Executive MBA programme be started in Management Institute.
- b. To start 'Entrepreneurship Development Centre'
 It was resolved that an "Entrepreneurship Development Centre be started in Management Institute.

(v) For Faculty of Allied Medical Sciences:

a. To procure sophisticated equipments in Physiotherapy OPD for patients benefits. It was resolved that sophisticated equipments be procured for treatment on patients in Physiotherapy OPD.

(vi) For Faculty of Nursing:

a. To start certificate course in Dental Nursing.

It was resolved that Certificate Course in Dental Nursing of one year's duration will be introduced from 2015-16. All 3rd year regular B.Sc. Nursing students can attend the course. It will be additional qualification for them. After completion of this course a certificate of Dental Nursing will be issued as additional qualification. This course will be started in Nursing college in coordination with Dental college.

Item No. BM-41-14: To consider recommendations made by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 22nd December, 2014 related to recommendations of Board of Research Studies.
